







In the United States and Canada, there are two organizations that confer credentials on practicing actuaries:

Society of Actuaries (SOA)

- Life Insurance, Annuities, Health Insurance, Pension Plans, etc
- SOA founded in 1889
- 23,298 members

Casualty Actuarial Society (CAS)

- Property and Casualty Insurance: Auto, Homeowners, Workers Compensation, and others
- CAS founded in 1914
- 5,650 members






CAS Mission Statement

- The purposes of the Casualty Actuarial Society are:
 - to advance the body of knowledge of actuarial science applied to general insurance, including property, casualty and similar risk exposures;
 - to expand the application of actuarial science to enterprise risks and systemic risks;
 - to establish and maintain standards of qualification for membership;
 - to promote and maintain high standards of conduct and competence;
 - to increase the awareness of actuarial science;
 - and, to contribute to the well being of society as a whole.



CAS Membership By Employment Type



Proposed CAS Exam structure

Beginning in January 2014, the following exams will be offered in place of 3L:

Exam LC – Life Contingencies and Survival Models

Exam ST – Statistics and Stochastic Modeling

Following this change, the CAS will still accept SOA exams P, FM, MFE, and C for credit for CAS exams 1, 2, 3F, and 4, respectively.
