

Applicant Frequently Asked Questions

1. I just applied to a position. What now?

After you apply, you will receive a confirmation e-mail that your application has been successfully submitted. Once you receive this confirmation, your application has been submitted for review. For some time, your application will be in the review process. No further action is required by you at this time.

2. How long until I hear about my application?

The length of time your application will be under review can vary depending on multiple factors, including the position that you are applying to and how many other applicants there are for that position. You will be notified as soon as there is a change in your application status via e-mail or phone.

3. What is the status of my application?

After you apply and until further notice, your application is in the review process. If you proceed past the review process, you will hear directly from a recruiter. Your recruiter will keep you informed of your status throughout the remainder of the hiring process.

4. <u>Where can I go for more information about the position I applied for?</u>
