The Allstate Corporation is North America's largest publicly held personal lines insurer.

A Fortune 500 company, with \$123.5 billion in assets, Allstate sells 13 major lines of insurance, including auto, property, life and commercial. Allstate also offers retirement and investment products and banking services. Allstate is widely known through the "You're In Good Hands With Allstate®" slogan in the US.

Allstate Northern Ireland celebrated its 10 year anniversary in October 2008, the company was incorporated in 1998 and commenced operation in 1999. With an initial cap of 250 employees, the Allstate Corporation quickly realised the opportunity in Northern Ireland regarding the wealth of skilled IT graduates. The company quickly reached its target of 250 employees and in the past 15 years has grown to over 2,250 employees over 3 locations.

Don't Text & Drive Road Safety Initiative

In 2010 Allstate Northern Ireland decided to launch the XtheTXT campaign in schools locally as part of Allstate's Community Responsibility program. The main principle is to educate young drivers and influenceattitudes and behaviors towards road safety. The team works in close partnership with the PSNI and DOE — a clear indication of the quality of the program.

Business in the Community judge, John Heaslip, said: "Allstate's X the TXT — Don't Text & Drive campaign sets the standard for good corporate social responsibility. It shows that when a business uses their unique skills in partnership with others, they can really make a difference in their community."

There is an issue in Northern Ireland with the amount of young people causing collisions due to texting whilst driving and our aim is to give young people vital information relating to the dangers and risks involved with carless driving. The campaign aims not only to reduce the number of collisions caused by texting and driving but to teach young people of the social and legal impacts it could have on their future.

Diversity

DIVERSE WORKFORCE

A significant factor in the success of Allstate NI's unprecedented growth in Northern Ireland, by which it has grown to over 2,250 professional IT employees in only 15 years, has been the company's ability to attract, retain and develop a diverse workforce. The definition of diversity is not restricted to representation of migrant workers, but extends to include a high representation of females in a male dominated industry, a high representation of employees with a disability and a diverse age range which includes employees over the normal age of retirement.

Allstate NI's Diversity and Equality Programme has successfully integrated diversity into the organisational culture. It is not a singular programme but an ongoing, integrated corporate initiative that enhances the company's ability to attract, motivate and retain a diverse pool of high performing employees necessary for a successful business.

Allstate NI has developed a comprehensive programme to support the integration of migrant workers and their families into the company and into Northern Ireland society. This includes providing assistance with setting up a local bank account and a 1 day accompanied tour of Belfast providing directions to the office, local shops and amenities, emergency services etc. All of this is reinforced by the 'Allstate NI Welcome to Northern Ireland' booklet, which reiterates much of this information and provides local maps, details of restaurants, reliable taxi firm numbers etc. English Language classes are also available for employees who would like to improve their English.
